STEAM Camp will be held at Mount Olive High School, 18 Corey Road, Flanders, NJ, in two one-week sessions for students who were in grades 1-7 during 2022-2023. Week 1 is July 17, 2023 to July 21, 2023. Week 2 is July 24, 2023 to July 28, 2023. Your child may sign up for one week or two—the choice is yours! The cost per week is \$250 per area child. Individual student schedules will be shared with families prior to the start of STEAM Camp. We will do our best to honor class requests; however, we reserve the right to make substitutions.

## Health and Safety

If there are any changes to the medical information you provided online, please notify our lead nurse, Liliana Duque-Dejesus, at liliana.duquedejesus@motsd.org, immediately!

Medical information must be provided to our STEAM Camp nurse prior to the start of Camp. Please note: Student-campers may be denied admission if the medical form is inaccurate or incomplete. In the event of serious illness or injury, parents will be notified immediately.

### Medications/Epi-Pens/Allergies

- Our STEAM Camp nurse <u>CAN</u> administer medication to your child. However, you must make the necessary arrangements with our nurse, as well as provide a doctor's note/order prior to the start of Camp. Parents/Guardians should drop off Epi-Pens and/or medications to the STEAM Camp nurse on the first day of Camp. All medications must be accompanied by the original physician's prescription with clearly written directions with proper doctor's orders. Please contact the STEAM Camp lead nurse, Liliana Duque-Dejesus, at liliana.duquedejesus@motsd.org, to make medication arrangements. No over the counter medications, such as cough drops, tums or tylenol, can be prescribed without a doctor's prescription.
- School lunches are peanut-free. There will be peanut-free tables in the cafeteria for any student with special dietary needs.

# Policies and What to Bring/Wear

It is our goal to ensure your child has a great experience during STEAM Camp. We always emphasize positive ways to deal with all situations. However, failure to adhere to the rules and policies of STEAM Camp may result in expulsion from the program without refund.

#### **Dress Code**

Parents/Guardians will be called to either bring a change of clothes or take their child home, if clothing is deemed inappropriate by our staff, per District Policy 5511 Dress and Grooming.

It is best that your child wear sneakers/proper play shoes. Crocs, jellies, flip-flops and other forms of open-toed shoes are dangerous in an environment full of play, science experiments, wood-cutting and outdoor activities.

> \*\*Please note: Not wearing sneakers may prevent your child from participating in planned activities.\*\*

While it is warm out, please make sure that your child wears age-appropriate clothes:

- No string tops, midriffs, tank tops, miniskirts, etc.
- No tight clothing
- Modest shorts (below fingertips when standing)
- No visible undergarments or see-through clothing
- No attire referencing alcoholic beverages, illegal substances, or lewd, vulgar, indecent and/or sexually suggestive subjects
- Other attire deemed inappropriate by our staff, per District Policy 5511 Dress and Grooming.

#### **Cell Phones**

• **STEAM** Camp provides a great opportunity for student-campers to connect and learn about others without having to use electronics. Therefore, please help us by stressing to your child that <u>cell</u> <u>phones cannot be used</u>. Any student-camper who uses his/her phone during our sessions will have to turn it in to the **STEAM** Camp staff. We will then call a parent to pick up the phone after school or the following morning. If the child is found using his/her phone again and/or inappropriately, other measures may result, such as but not limited to, staff holding the phone until the program ends.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Please make sure that your child wears **sunscreen** and has a **water bottle** each day during Camp. All belongings should be labeled with your child's name in case of items being misplaced.

#### When is STEAM Camp running?

**STEAM** Camp runs two one-week sessions, from 8:30 am to 1:30 pm, Monday through Friday, for students who were in Grades 1-7 during the 2022-2023 school year.

Week 1: July 17, 2023-July 21, 2023 Week 2: July 24, 2023-July 28, 2023

#### Your child may sign up for one week or two.

Registration begins now and ends on Friday, June 23, 2023. To guarantee your child a STEAM Camp spot, full payment is due at the time of registration. If paying by check or cash, your child's registration cannot be confirmed until payment is received.

#### Who can attend STEAM Camp?

All Mount Olive Township School District students who were in grades 1-7 during the 2022-2023 school year are welcome! We are pleased to accept international students this year.

# My child has already done Mount Olive STEAM Camp. What are you changing to make it new and exciting?

Many of our activities and classes will be new for 2023 and are designed to enrich our student-campers' experiences. Furthermore, since Mount Olive High School will continue to host **STEAM** Camp, our student-campers can see and take advantage of our state-of-the-art facilities.

#### Will there be busing for Mount Olive residents?

No. We require parent/guardian or authorized individual drop-off and pick-up.

#### Who will teach the program?

Each **STEAM** Camp activity that your child attends will have a certified teacher. These professionals understand the unique social and emotional needs of children, as well as how to motivate our student campers through hands-on activities.

#### I have a special needs child who wants to attend. What supports do you offer?

Special education services will not be provided during the **STEAM** Camp program. All Mount Olive Township School District children who were in grades 1-7 during the 2022-2023 school year are invited, but all student-campers will receive the same level of services. However, we have certified teachers who can make reasonable accommodations to help a variety of learners have a great experience.

#### Will there be a nurse?

#### Is before and aftercare provided?

No. Before and aftercare are not provided.

#### What is the cost of STEAM Camp?

**STEAM** Camp's tuition is \$250 per Mount Olive student-camper per week.

#### What is your Registration Deadline and Policy?

**REGISTRATION POLICY:** To guarantee your child a STEAM Camp spot, **full payment is due at the time of registration.** 

Registration opens now and closes on Friday, June 23, 2023.

• Return Drafts or Checks for Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF)—Any drafts of checks returned for Non-Sufficient Funds will be subject to an additional \$35 service charge.
